Read Acts 9:10-19

- What does the sending of Ananias tell us about how God felt about Saul despite his past behaviour?
- Have you ever experienced God sending someone to minister to you in your time of need?
- What difficulties might Saul have faced in becoming a Christian?
- Share any obstacles that you face in fully committing to Jesus.

Read Acts 26:22-29

- How did Saul's experiences help him to become a great evangelist?
- Share your experiences of sharing your testimony with others.

Pray

- That the current situation might cause each person to renew their relationship with Jesus and recommit their lives to His service.
- Through any obstacles that people are facing in fully committing to Christ
- That God will help each person to use their own testimony to share the gospel message of Christ with others
